Geographic representation of members. report) 2. Proficiency testing. 3. IDF/ ISO validation protocol. 4. AQAS. Progress: 1. We now have better geographical representation with new members from England, Eastern Europe, and Africa. Two of the new members from South America and Africa have since left the group. However it is believed that we have adequate cover and we should only replace these members if we can find members who are going to be actively involved. Completed 2. Proficiency testing. Big progress here with Silvia being employed by ICAR and taking coordination of the ICAR PT scheme under ICAR control. The limits to evaluate the SCC PT, have been extended to 10 %. In Progress 3. IDF/ ISO validation protocol. Silvia is leader of this IDF / ISO standard. Draft standard currently being reviewed by the IDF / ISO Action team. Once completed decision to be made whether ICAR certifies milk test instruments against this standard (similar to what is done for milk meters). In Progress 4. AQAS – Discussion with the Board at last meeting followed up by discussion on MA SC conference call November 2015. Decision taken to put this on the back burners and revisit at a later date. On Hold **Priorities** 1. Continue the roll out of the ICAR global PT scheme. for next year 2. Certification of milk analysers against the completed IDF / ISO 3. Involved with rollout of SCC reference system 4. Review of ICAR Guidelines. Some initial discussion already started in group around usability – looks like ICAR Board may be looking at similar issues. 5. Coordinate program for Edinburgh conference Issues which the Certification of milk analysers against the completed IDF / ISO Group wishes ICAR standard and ICAR protocol.
