I enclose two documents as a starting point for discussion, one is the USDA proposal for an interim code structure to be used in UHF tags in North America pending the development of an International Standard. The other is a scheme proposed by ScotEID to allow Scottish cattle to carry official passport details on a UHF tag. Both of these proposals address localised requirements and demonstrate the diversity of schemes in the absence of an IS.
