24h yield calculation methods in Polish recorded herds according to milk recording methods

Milk recording service is offered worldwide for the farmers in many milk recording methods. The choice of MR method is usually a compromise between conditions at the farm (milking system), time consumption for data collection and results accuracy. A4 method is a reference method for all the others. But within any milk recording method we can only observe and record the current yield on that very day – or a particular milking. That is why the most accurate 24h yield calculation is so important. In order to guarantee results accuracy for farm management, Milk Recording Organisations have to ensure appropriate data collection and 24h yield calculation which is the base for any further calculation. This presentation shows some recent changes in MR methods distribution in Polish recorded herds and adaptation of 24h yield calculation in new applied MR methods.
