- Initiative by ICAR Secretariat in April 2006
- PSAS website launched in July 2006
- Service managed by ICAR Secretariat
- One external expert as legal adviser (US)
- 21 member organizations (out of which, 20 ICAR members)
- Geographical coverage: Europe, America, Australia and Africa

PSAS Terms of reference

- The service is based on an international network for the exchange of information on animal patenting. Members share information on the network with the aim to create a centralized, ICAR-managed pool of patenting-related information from a wide range of countries worldwide.

PSAS Mission
